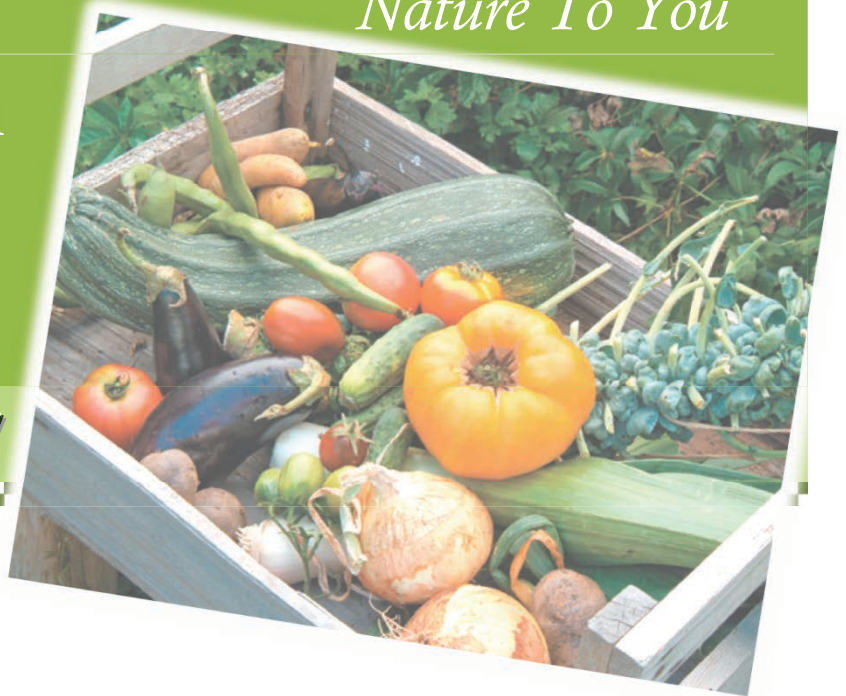


Teva To You

How it works:

Cost: The cost of the produce is \$22 per week. There are several payment plans – please website for more information.

What you get: Each weekly share is considered sufficient for a family of four. Items may include: tomatoes, baby carrots, lettuce, radishes, strawberries, herbs, fennel, fava beans, potatoes, peppers, green onions, beets, squash, apples and much, much more!

When you get it: Starting March 14th, you can pick up your share weekly at the JCC on Wednesdays from 12-6pm.

What is Teva To You?

Teva is the Hebrew word for nature. Teva To You is a program that is designed to support small local farms and create a vibrant Jewish community by providing people with the opportunity to purchase and eat local, organic and sustainable produce and participate in educational programs that explore the intersection of food and Jewish tradition.

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. CSA members purchase their "shares" in advance and then pick up their produce once a week from the JCC during the growing season - March through November.
