An exhibition of stereographs (old photographs) of the Holy Land, originally published in 1914. These exceptional images reveal the spirit of multiculturalism that prevailed in this region where Jews, Muslims, and Christians all lived. For centuries, pilgrims have sought a spiritual connection to this land by traveling to sacred sites and religious monuments.
